## Can you check them all?



Create an independent advocacy assistance ombuds program for people with intellectual/developmental disabilities, including the legislative language to codify the program in law (S.3108/A.1577, in the Senate one-house).	
Expand Essential Plan eligibility and include all income-eligible immigrants.

Promote access to community-based long-term services and supports by
